

HILLCREST INDOOR PISTOL CLUB

RANGE RULES

1. **Under No circumstances is a pregnant woman allowed inside the range.**
2. Firearms brought into the Range. Must be unloaded and checked by the Range Officer.
3. Rifles allowed on the range are to be in pistol calibres only.
4. No Persons under the Influence of alcohol or drugs allowed on the range.
5. Visitors to the range must be accompanied by a club member.
6. Eye and Ear protection must be worn at all Times whilst on the range.
7. Do not remove Eye & Ear protection when leaving the range until you are outside both Exit Doors.
8. No Smoking, Eating or Drinking on the Range.
9. Holsters may only be used by people wearing 'Holster Competency Cards' for relevant competitions only.
10. Only 1 person to shoot at any one time in each bay. (Only 1 gun at any time).
11. Load and unload weapons inside the shooting bay only. (Not behind the line).
12. Keep firearms always pointed downrange, whilst loading, unloading and shooting. Trigger finger outside trigger guard at all times until firing.
13. Never pass your firearms from one person to another, always place the firearms on the bench and let them pick it up from there.
14. Prior to leaving the range, always press the Range Officer call systems, and have the Range Officer clear your weapons. (Red light will come on)
15. If your weapon malfunctions, or you require the Range Officers assistance, press the range officer call system, and the Range Officer will be with you shortly.
16. Club guns must be used with our Ammo only, for insurance reasons.
17. Enclosed footwear MUST be worn by all people on the range.
18. Shoot only at your own target, not at other peoples target, also do not shoot at any range signs, lights or anything on the range floor.
19. Range Officer have total control of this range, and instructions MUST be obeyed, Failure to follow Range Officer instructions, will result in the Person being removed from the premises. Remember these rules are for your safety as well as others.
20. All weapons cases to be put on the tables behind shooting line. One case at a time to be taken to the shooting bench, weapon to be cleared by Range Officer. Empty gun case is then returned to back wall. On completion of shoot, weapon is cleared by Range Officer and re-cased at the shooting line.
21. Persons attending the Range MUST be able to speak and understand English this so that they are able to understand Range Officers, and safety Instructions.
22. Exit the Range from the Exit door only.
23. Place your old targets, and ammunition boxes, in the rubbish bin provided near the EXIT DOOR, thank you.
24. Please wash your hands when you leave the Range, to remove any Lead Residues.
25. No Phone calls to be made or received on the Range. (Photos / Videos are permitted).
26. Green lights on the range indicate shooter may go forward of the shooting line, i.e. range is clear. (All Green Lights must be on before proceeding forward).
27. Any person considered breaching any safety rules will be given a warning. If rule is breached again, the person will be suspended from shooting activities.
28. Any person committing an unsafe or anti-social act shall be liable for suspension, disqualification or expulsion from the club.
